State-wide programs with searchable food resource maps.

- **[Hunger Solutions](#)**: Searchable tool for all of Minnesota
- **[Fare for All](#)**: A pop-up grocery store in your community. Sells frozen meats and fresh produce food packages for up to 40% off retail prices. Accepts cash, credit, debit and EBT cards.
- **Salvation Army**: Has a network of food programs and locations throughout the US.
 - Salvation Army has an [online tool](#) that locates sites near you. The map will also tell you what services are offered at the location, including food.
- **[Mobile App: Free Meals for Kids](#)**: The mobile app will help families and kids find free meals at schools and other sites across Minnesota.
 - Kids 18 and under or family members can receive free meals. Powered by GPS, the free app shows locations that provide meals and meal packs, as well as days and hours for distribution, distance and directions to the nearest site.
