

Lebanon Hills Greenway

PROJECT BACKGROUND:

The Lebanon Hills Greenway will create a vital connection from Lebanon Hills Regional Park to the broader Dakota County greenway system. This segment will run along Dodd Road from Cliff Road to Wescott Road and include a new trail connection from Cliff Road to the Lebanon Hills Visitor Center. The project will enhance access to the park while providing safe, accessible trail connections for bicyclists and pedestrians throughout Inver Grove Heights and Eagan.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

This project will complete final design for the Lebanon Hills Greenway segment while:

- Creating safe, accessible trail connections
- Adding rest areas and wayfinding signage
- Enhancing landscaping and visual management
- Connecting the greenway to Lebanon Hills Visitor Center

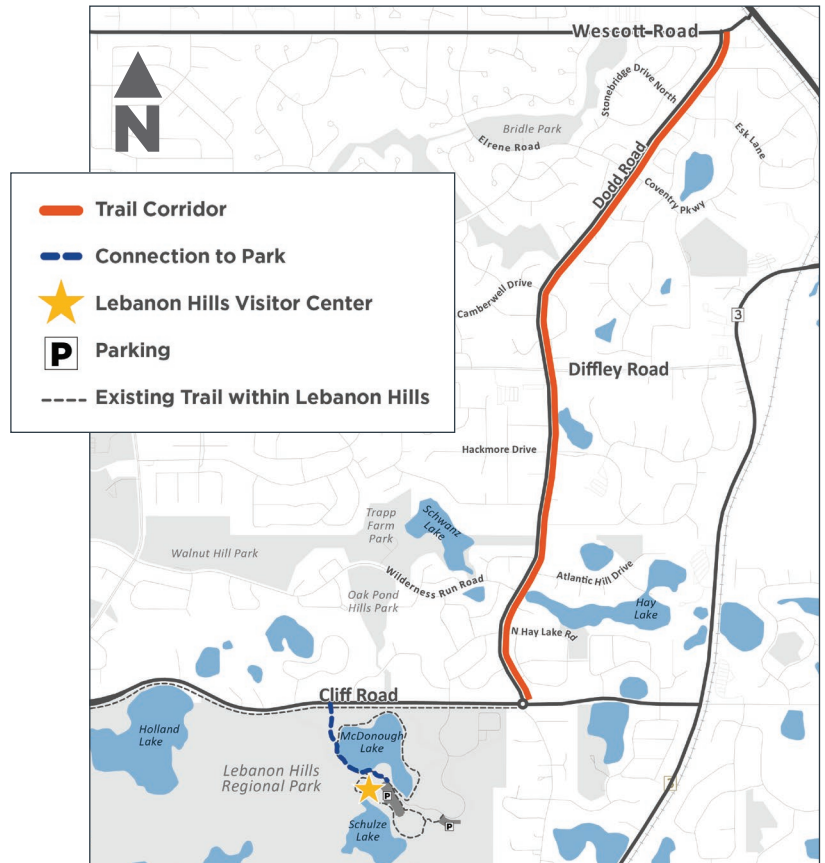
SCHEDULE:

Construction expected to begin



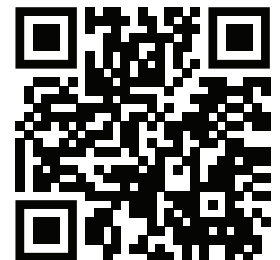
