Welcome to Whitetail Woods Regional Park, a 456-acre oasis in the heart of Dakota County. Miles of scenic trails meander through this spectacular park to showcase Empire Lake and the rolling hills, century-old oaks and pristine wetlands that surround it.

Whitetail Woods Regional Park is part of the Dakota County Park System.

Admission and parking are free.

Park features

- Camper cabins (open year-round)
- Sledding hill
- 5+ miles of groomed classic cross-country ski trails
- 3+ miles of winter hiking/snowshoeing trails
- 2+ miles of cleared paved trails
- Trail connection to UMORE Park and the Lone Rock Trail

So everyone can enjoy the park...

- Use trails for their intended purpose.
- Leashed pets are welcome on non-ski trails. Please put pet waste in the garbage.

Cross-country ski pass

A Dakota County Parks ski pass is required for skiers age 18 and older. Passes are only available online at www.dakotacounty.us/parks, search *ski pass*, or in person at the Lebanon Hills Visitor Center. Daily passes are \$6 and season passes are \$25. There are no pay boxes at trailheads.
